

Code Of Conduct For Trustees Seeking Support From Camden Giving

Purpose of policy:

To protect Camden Giving's reputation and ensure transparency.

Related policies: Conflict of Interest Policy, Complaints policy

Date agreed: 25/9/18

Policy

- 1. Trustees are entitled to apply for funding, volunteer support and any other support o behalf of an organisation Camden Giving is able to provide where there is a declared conflict of interest.
- 2. Trustees should declare their intention to make an application to the Chair of Trustees* either at a Camden Giving Trustee meeting or via email so this can be placed on record. They should state:
 - a. That they have informed any joint applicants of their Conflict Of Interest
 - b. That they have declared any joint applications to other joint applications they are undertaking
- 3. *If the Chair of Trustees makes an application, they should inform the Treasurer following the same process.
- 4. Where possible, Trustees should make efforts not to be the named person handling applications.
- 5. Trustees can raise complaints about the process but not the decision which will be escalated to all Trustees.
